Amplify

Curate sustained engagement with national and global decision-makers and funders to adopt and expand solutions quickly and widely and evaluate impact.

To achieve our ambitious agenda, we work across three transformations; **Education Workforce, System Delivery, and School Health and Nutrition.**

These transformations are underpinned by a strong focus on addressing marginalization, building system resistance, and facilitating cross-sectoral collaboration.



The Education Workforce Initiative (EWI) is catalyzing efforts to support teachers and leverage the wider education workforce by drawing on the latest evidence and innovations to strengthen school and system leadership; advance the use of learning teams approaches; and improve the supply and quality of teaching for the most marginalized.



The System Delivery transformation builds on our previous DeliverEd work on delivery approaches and aims to work with governments to use evidence and data to prioritize, problem-solve, and improve organizational learning at all levels of the education system and embed problem-solving practices throughout the delivery chain.



The Sustainable Financing Initiative for School Health and Nutrition (SFI) is an initiative of the School Meals Coalition. It works with governments and donors to help countries develop multi-year financing strategies for school feeding programs with a particular focus on low- and lower - middle - income countries.
